1. Tom Fredrick Smith will complete, file with the Registry of this Court, and deliver to Jane Ann Smith a sworn Financial Statement in Form 8 of the Supreme Court Family Rules including all required attachments by February 25, 2015.

#### Part 2: FACTUAL BASIS

1. The parties began cohabiting on or about JUL/02/2000.
2. The parties were married on AUG/15/2000.
3. The parties separated on MAY/15/2014.
4. The parties are parents of the following children:
  - a. Mike Scott Smith born 22/JUNE/2005;
  - b. James Brian Smith born 22/JUNE/2005.
5. The Applicant filed a Notice of Family Claim on 02/NOV/2014 claiming child support and spousal support.
6. The Applicant served the Respondent with her financial statement and requested they disclose their financial statements on 03/JAN/2015.
7. The Applicant sent a letter to the Respondent on 28/JAN/2015 requesting financial statements or information regarding their annual income.
8. The Applicant has yet to receive any information regarding the Respondent's finances.

  - (ii) a copy of each of the filed affidavits and other documents that you intend to refer to at the hearing of this application and that has not already been served on that person;
  - (iii) if this application is brought under Rule 11-3, any notice that you are required to give under Rule 11-3(9).

**Time for response to application**

The documents referred to in paragraph (c) above must be served in accordance with that paragraph,

- (a) unless one of the following paragraphs applies, within 5 business days after service of this notice of application,
- (b) if this application is brought under Rule 11-3, within 8 business days after service of this notice of application, and
- (c) if this application is brought to change, suspend or terminate a final order or to set aside or replace the whole or any part of an agreement filed under Rule 2-1(2), within 14 business days after service of this notice of application.
